The Farm at South Village is a certified organic farm and the central core of the South Village Communities LLC, located in South Burlington, Vermont. Dedicated to community supported agriculture, the farm is committed to reconnecting residents and neighbors with the land to produce a healthy and sustainable environment. In its second year in production, the farm has expanded to 4 acres, continuing the goal of revitalizing farmland and developing a prime agricultural resource in our region.



The Farm at South Village CSA provides members with a weekly share of farm fresh vegetables from June through October. The CSA is managed by Burlington resident Bobby Young with consultation from veteran Vermont organic farmer David Miskell of Charlotte. Crops for the CSA will be grown on the FSV land, in Miskell's greenhouses in Charlotte and in Burlington's Intervale, where Bobby will break ground with his new farm business, Hens & Hands.

In its second year, the FSV CSA has increased the variety and quality of produce available to members and has added many other local farm products including fruit, bread, cheese, and sustainably raised meats. The FSV CSA is committed to providing the best value for local and organic foods possible. Crops will be harvested as close to the day of pick up to provide members with the freshest, most nutritious and high quality food available.

**The Farm at South Village 2010 CSA Vegetable Share and Localvore Add On's
June – October Weekly Pick Ups Mondays 4 - 7 PM at South Village**

Vegetable Shares \$375...best value in Chittenden County!

Bobby is willing to help connect members together who want to split a vegetable share. People can purchase a full share together and they will be responsible for breaking up the full share upon pickup.

The **Vegetable Share** provides farm fresh, certified organic vegetables every week from June through October. Shares feed 2-3 healthy vegetable eaters and offer over 30 different crops throughout the growing season. The vegetable share is a huge cost savings to members at 30% below retail value. The amount per week will vary based on seasonality and field conditions. The vegetable share also includes a variety of Pick Your Own crops available for members to harvest at the Farm at South Village. PYO crops include peas, beans, cherry tomatoes, herbs and cut flowers. Below are examples of a weekly share:

June – 1 lb Carrots, 2 Cucumbers, 6-10 Garlic Scapes, 1 Head Lettuce, ½ lb Salad Mix,
1 Bunch Scallions, ½ lb Spinach, 1 Bunch Salad Turnips

August – 1 lb Beets, 1 lb Carrots, 6 Ears Sweet Corn, 2 Cucumbers, 1 Bulb Garlic, 1 Head Lettuce, 1 lb Onions,
1 lb Sweet Peppers, 1 lb Potatoes, 4 Tomatoes, 2 Zucchini

Add On Shares Choose from any of the following options to add on to your vegetable share. From fruit to bread and cheese, the Farm at South Village is committed to supporting other local farms and providing CSA members with a wide variety of farm fresh food. Prices for add on shares are below the retail value of these products. If you would like more info on the value of each share, please contact us.

Fruit \$50

Organic fruit grown in the Intervale by Adam's Berry Farm and Diggers Mirth Collective Farm. Fruit shares include 2 pints of strawberries in June, 2 pints of blueberries in July, 1 watermelon and 2 cantaloupes in August and 2 pints of raspberries in September.

Meat Medley \$200

From July to October you will receive from 4 to 6 lbs of a variety of meats each month raised by Jericho Settlers' Farm. Meats will be frozen and most will be in cryovac packaging with label of cut type and weight. Here is an example of a monthly share: *3.5 lbs pasture raised chicken, 1 lb pasture raised pork sausage, 1 summer sausage (pasture raised pork & 100% grass fed beef, 1 lb 100% grass fed beef.* www.jerichosettlersfarm.com

Bread \$85

Freshly baked bread by O Bread Bakery at Shelburne Farms. Bread shares include one loaf every week and three different varieties (baguette, sesame wheat and French round) will be rotated throughout the entire 20 weeks.

Cheese \$78

Cheddar cheese produced by Shelburne Farms. Cheese shares include a ¾ lb block every other week.

Chicken \$60 or \$120

4-6 lbs Pasture Raised Chickens \$120 every other week (6 chickens total)
\$60 once per month (3 chickens total)
Pastured raised chicken produced by Rockville Market Farm in Starksboro. Chickens cost \$20 each and come whole and frozen. They are available from July-September, every other week or once per month.
